- # Annual membership fees (& RQ fees) are due on 1st January. After this date, only paid members can row and membership lapses when membership fees are in arrears for at least 2 months.
- # Discounts are available to immediate family members who are financially dependant including children, only when paying full year fees.
2nd family member - 25 % discount; 3rd & subsequent family members - 30% discount. Discounts are not available to extended family members.

- # School rowers pay by the term for the school rowing program (terms 2 & 3). School to collect fees. Application for Junior rowing in terms 1 & 4 to be considered for approval by the committee.
- # School rowers competing outside of the local Townsville All Schools competition must upgrade to RQ category of Junior Competitive Regional. Fee is \$62
- # Non-rowing coxes are classified as Social Members for fee purposes, but must pay full rowers fees if they wish to row.
- # Learn-to-row participants wishing to continue rowing and upgrade membership, pay normal club fees when joining the club, less \$16 off their RQ fee if upgrading in same calendar year.
- # The fee to Rowing Queensland includes personal injury insurance (Details on RQ website) and Professional Indemnity Insurance for coaches.
- # RQ defines that a competitor ceases to be an Under 19 (Junior) on 31 December of the calendar year in which he /she reaches the age of eighteen.
